# Sangli and Nagpur to get CABA

India HIV/AIDS Alliance with NMP+ and Avert society had a meeting with MSACS Project Director Mr. Ramesh Devkar. CABA is Children Affected By HIV/AIDS. This is a pilot project and will be implemented in 10 districts of India. Sangli and Nagpur districts are been selected from Maharashtra state. The objective of the project is

- To implement a multi-sectoral approach of providing comprehensive package of services to children affected by HIV/AIDS
- 2. Establish district and community level coordination mechanisms
- 3. Build the knowledge and capacity of all the departments concerned with providing services for children to meet the needs of CABA

NMP+ will be District Lead Agency for Sangli & Avert Society will be the District Lead Agency for Nagpur.
